Many people are interested in history and historic preservation but may not be ready to commit to the responsibilities of chapter membership or attending regular meetings. Others may simply wish to support our mission while participating as their schedules allow.

Members-at-Large receive Arizona State and International electronic communications, have access to our website, and can stay informed about projects, programs, and events. They may choose to participate in preservation projects, educational activities, or other opportunities that match their interests and availability.

This membership category also gives us an opportunity to connect with individuals who have valuable skills that can benefit our organization. Whether someone has experience with social media, website management, graphic design, photography, fundraising, grant writing, or another area of expertise, Member-at-Large offers a way for them to contribute without the expectation of regular chapter attendance. Because Members-at-Large are not affiliated with a chapter, chapter officers have no ongoing administrative responsibilities for them.

Joining is simple. The Membership Application is available on the Arizona State website. Applicants simply select **Member-at-Large**, complete the form, and submit it with their dues to the State Treasurer.
